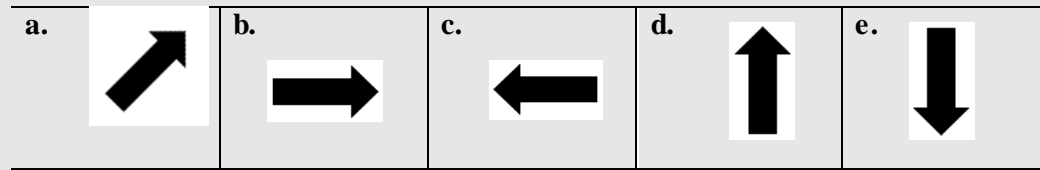

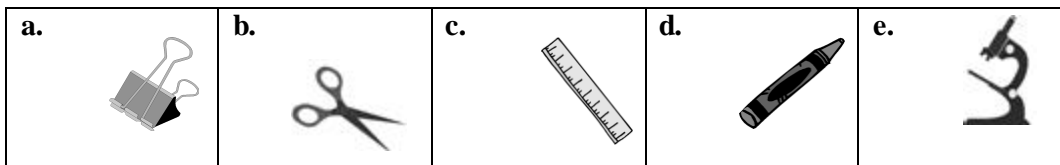
Directions: Choose the picture in your Test Book that you hear described. Look at the example below:

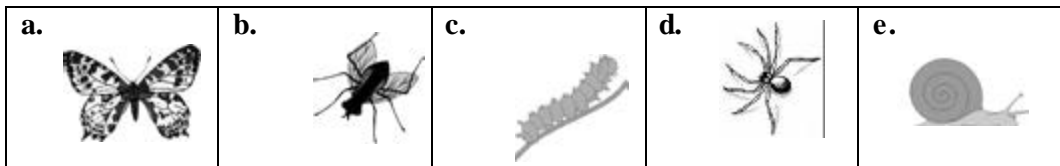

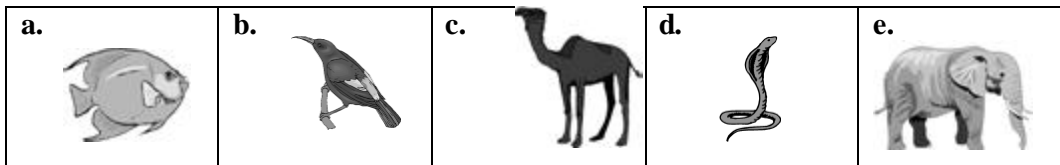
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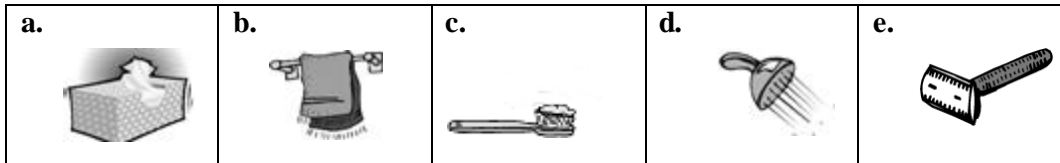
